Know all men by these presents: That, it appearing from the records of the International Association of Assessing Officers that a qualifying number of members in good standing of the said Association residing in the State of Tennessee, having heretofore complied with all the rules and regulations prescribed by said Association for the organization of official state or local chapters, we, the undersigned, by virtue of authority vested in us do hereby declare the

Tennessee Chapter
of the

International Association of Assessing Officers

to be organized and established from and after the date hereof, and do further declare that said chapter shall exercise all the powers, assume all the obligations, and enjoy all the rights and privileges of an official chapter, as may now or hereafter be provided by the constitution of the International Association of Assessing Officers, or any by-law or resolution adopted thereunder, until this charter has been revoked in the manner heretofore provided.
